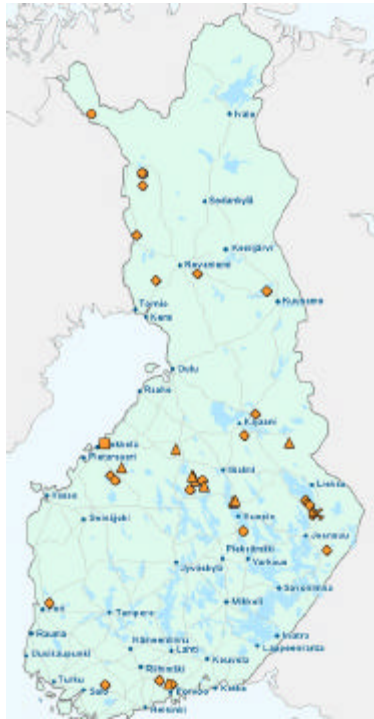

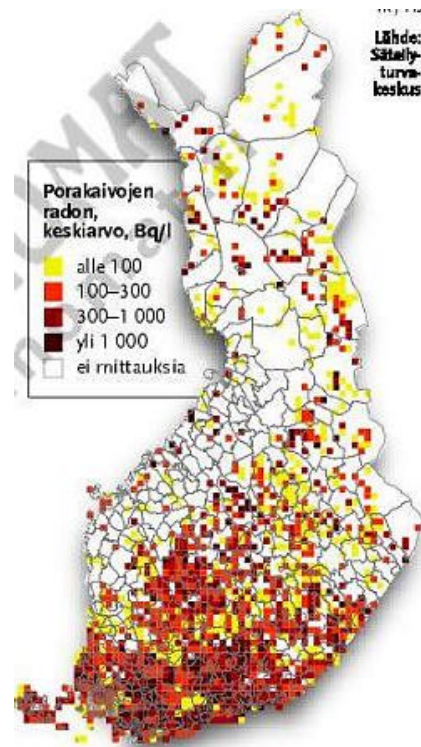

Uranium claims in Finland 1955 -



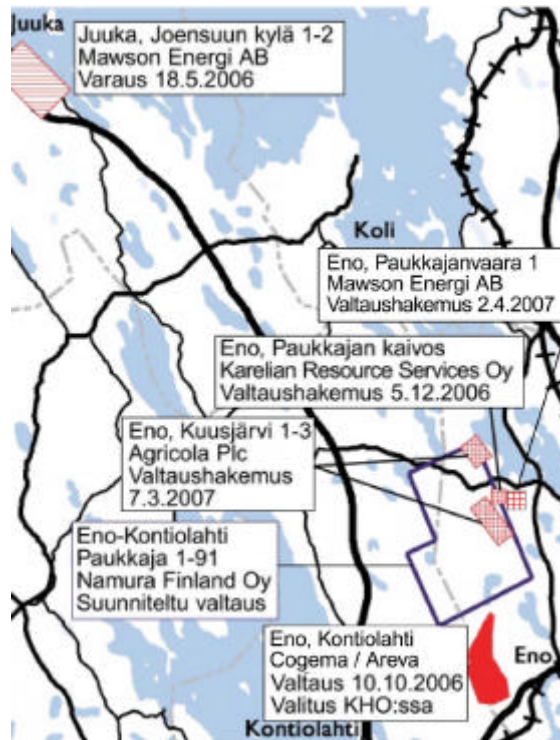
- over 600 uranium claims, one mine in Paukkajanvaara 1958-61
- most of them: Helsinki surroundings, North Karelia, Kuusamo, Western Lapland
- Atomivoima, amateurs, business mens, Imatran Voima, Outokumpu Oy, GTK
- Geological Survey of Finland (GTK). Systematic ore survey since 1885
- geologically well known country

Radon in drilled wells



- uranium splits \downarrow radon
- may indicate uranium deposit
- people live in southern Finland so most checked wells are there
- not very much survey in Eastern and Northern Finland
- Karelidian mountains, 2-3 milliard years old (Koli)
- same kind of ground than in uranium areas for example in Canada

The origins of the Movement against uranium mining in North Karelia

- The movement born 3.3.2006
- The Finnish Association for Nature Conservation
- Cogema / Areva claim application
- No information, uncertainty about future, lack on knowledge, "What happens?"
- Spontaneous local activity rises in Eno and Kontiolahti counties
- Local Nature Conservation Societies came with
- Informal wider organisation: "**Movement against uranium mining in North Karelia**".



Why we are against uranium mines

- uranium mine maybe brings some job, but same time it takes them of and blocks new work. Bioenergy will give thousand new jobs for example in North Karelia.
- tourism and other nature based business are important in Finland and those are possible only in clean nature

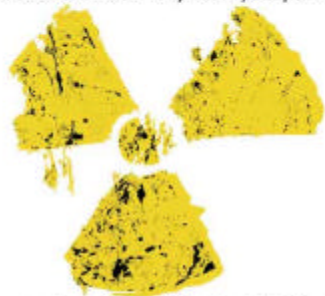
